


GREEN MICRO-INTERNSHIPS

The Micro-Internship Program is a unique opportunity designed for students eager to explore sustainable career paths. Participants spend a day at an environmentallyfocused workplace, where they engage with professionals in the field and gain firsthand experience on what a typical day looks like in the workplace.

Throughout the day, students observe daily operations, participate in discussions, and become familiar with the various projects the workplace is undertaking.
